SUBCHAPTER Z. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

- Sec. 233.901. COUNTY BUILDING PERMIT IN EXTRATERRITORIAL 9 JURISDICTION PROHIBITED. A county may not require a permit to erect 10 or improve a building or other structure in the extraterritorial 11 jurisdiction of a municipality, as defined by Chapter 42. 12
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and 13 applies only to an application for a permit submitted on or after 14 that date. An application for a permit submitted before that date 15 is governed by the law in effect when the application was submitted, 16 17 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
