4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 21, Property Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 21.0121 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 21.0121. CONDEMNATION TO ACQUIRE WATER RIGHTS.
8	(a) In addition to the contents prescribed by Section 21.012(b), a
9	condemnation petition filed by a political subdivision of this
10	state for the purpose of acquiring rights to groundwater or surface
11	water must state that the facts to be proven are that the political
12	subdivision has:
13	(1) prepared a drought contingency plan;
14	(2) developed and implemented a water conservation
15	plan that will result in the highest practicable levels of water
16	conservation and efficiency achievable in the political
17	subdivision's jurisdiction;
18	(3) made a bona fide good faith effort to obtain
19	practicable alternative water supplies to the water rights the
20	political subdivision proposes to condemn;
21	(4) made a bona fide good faith effort to acquire the
22	rights to the water the political subdivision proposes to condemn
23	by voluntary purchase or lease; and
24	(5) made a showing that the political subdivision

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- 1 needs the water rights to provide for the domestic needs of the
- 2 political subdivision within the next 10-year period.
- 3 (b) A court shall deny the right to condemn unless the
- 4 political subdivision proves to the court that the political
- 5 <u>subdivision</u> has met the requirements of Subsection (a).
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
