A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the issuance of special "United We Stand" license 3 plates.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 502.2664 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 502.2664. UNITED WE STAND LICENSE PLATES. (a) The
- 8 department shall issue specially designed patriotic license plates
- 9 for passenger cars and light trucks to support the Texas Military
- 10 Preparedness Grant Account.
- 11 (b) The license plates must bear the words "United We Stand"
- and use only the colors red, white, blue, and black.
- 13 (c) The department shall issue license plates under this
- 14 section to a person who:
- 15 (1) applies to the tax assessor-collector of the
- 16 county in which the person resides on the form for original
- 17 registration or annual renewal of registration provided by the
- department; and
- 19 (2) pays an annual fee of \$30, in addition to the fee
- 20 prescribed by Section 502.161 and, if personalized prestige license
- 21 plates are issued, in addition to the fee prescribed by Section
- 22 502.251.

- 23 (d) The department shall deposit \$20 of each fee collected
- 24 under this section to the credit of the Texas Military Preparedness

- 1 Grant Account in the general revenue fund.
- 2 (e) The remainder of each fee collected under this section,
- 3 after deposit as provided by Subsection (d), shall be deposited to
- 4 the credit of the state highway fund and may be used only to defray
- 5 the cost of administering this section.
- 6 (f) The fee for replacement of a lost, stolen, or mutilated
- 7 license plate issued under this section is \$30, in addition to the
- 8 <u>fee prescribed by Section 502.184(a).</u>
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect only if another Act of the
- 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, creates the Texas Military
- 12 Preparedness Grant Account and becomes law. If no Act of the 78th
- 13 Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, creates the account and becomes
- 14 law, this Act has no effect.
