1-6 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO. 1 By: West

1-7 Amend S.B. No. 1232 in SECTION 1 of the bill by adding Subsection
1-8 (e), Section 11.163, Education Code, as follows:

1-9 (e) If a district has less than 10 days notice during the
1-10 school year that a job vacancy will occur in a teaching position,
1-11 the district shall post the job vacancy but may proceed to fill the
1-12 vacant position.

1-13 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-14 AN ACT

1-15 relating to school district job postings.

1-16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-17 SECTION 1. Section 11.163, Education Code, is amended by
1-18 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

1-19 (d) The employment policy must provide that all job
1-20 vacancies be posted, for at least 10 working days, by the district
1-21 in a place readily accessible to the public and that all current
1-22 employees be given an opportunity to apply for open positions.

1-23 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2003-2004
1-24 school year.

1-25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-28 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-29 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
