mechanism by which the department identifies money appropriated to the department to provide care for a person who lives in a nursing facility and redirects that money within the department's budget to provide community-based services when the person leaves the nursing facility to live in the community with the assistance of those

services during the state fiscal biennium to persons who leave

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SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2004, the Texas Department of Human Services shall develop and implement the mechanism for redirecting money as required by Section 22.006,

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- 1 Human Resources Code, as added by this Act.
- 2 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 3 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 4 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 5 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 6 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 7 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
