9	SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
10	amended by adding Sections 411.0161 and 411.0162 to read as
11	follows:
12	Sec. 411.0161. SUPPLEMENTAL PAY FOR PROFICIENCY
13	CERTIFICATION. (a) Subject to the availability of funds and except
14	as provided by Subsection (d), an officer commissioned by the
15	department who has been issued one of the following proficiency
16	certificates by the Commission on Law Enforcement Officer Standards
17	and Education is entitled to supplemental pay in the amount of:
18	(1) \$100 a month for an intermediate peace officer
19	proficiency certificate or an equivalent certificate;
20	(2) \$200 a month for an advanced peace officer
21	proficiency certificate or an equivalent certificate; or
22	(3) \$300 a month for a master peace officer
23	proficiency certificate or an equivalent certificate.
24	(b) If an officer has been issued more than one of the

1	certificates described by Subsection (a), the officer is entitled
2	only to the amount of supplemental pay attributable to the most
3	advanced certificate issued to the officer.
4	(c) An officer who is entitled to supplemental pay under
5	this section is entitled to that pay in addition to the officer's
6	regular compensation for as long as the proficiency certification
7	is in effect.
8	(d) An officer who receives supplemental pay under this
9	section may not receive supplemental pay for obtaining a higher
10	education degree under Section 411.0162.
11	Sec. 411.0162. SUPPLEMENTAL PAY FOR OBTAINING HIGHER
12	EDUCATION DEGREE. (a) Subject to the availability of funds and
13	except as provided by Subsection (c), an officer commissioned by
14	the department who has obtained one of the following degrees from an
15	accredited public or private college or university is entitled to
16	supplemental pay in the amount of:
17	(1) \$100 a month for an associate's degree;
18	(2) \$200 a month for a bachelor's degree; or
19	(3) \$300 a month for a master's degree or more advanced
20	degree.
21	(b) If an officer has obtained more than one of the degrees
22	described by Subsection (a), the officer is entitled only to the
23	amount of supplemental pay attributable to the most advanced degree
24	obtained by the officer.
25	(c) An officer who receives supplemental pay under this
26	section may not receive supplemental pay for proficiency
27	certification under Section 411.0161.
