- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 502.2862 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 502.2862. ELECTRIC PERSONAL ASSISTIVE MOBILITY
- 8 DEVICES. The owner of an electric personal assistive mobility
- 9 device, as defined by Section 551.201, is not required to register
- 10 the electric personal assistive mobility device.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 541.201(11), Transportation Code, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 "Motor vehicle" means a self-propelled vehicle or
- 14 a vehicle that is propelled by electric power from overhead trolley
- 15 wires. The term does not include an electric bicycle or an electric
- 16 personal assistive mobility device, as defined by Section 551.201.
- SECTION 3. Section 547.001(7), Transportation Code, is
- 18 amended to read as follows:
- 19 "Slow-moving vehicle" means:
- 20 (A) a motor vehicle designed to operate at a
- 21 maximum speed of 25 miles per hour or less, not including an
- 22 electric personal assistive mobility device, as defined by Section
- 23 551.201; or
- 24 (B) a vehicle, implement of husbandry, or

- 1 machinery, including road construction machinery, that is towed by:
- 2 (i) an animal; or
- 3 (ii) a motor vehicle designed to operate at
- 4 a maximum speed of 25 miles per hour or less.
- 5 SECTION 4. Section 551.001, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 551.001. PERSONS AFFECTED. Except as provided by
- 8 Subchapter C, this [This] chapter applies only to a person
- 9 operating a bicycle on:
- 10 (1) a highway; or
- 11 (2) a path set aside for the exclusive operation of
- 12 bicycles.
- 13 SECTION 5. Chapter 551, Transportation Code, is amended by
- 14 adding Subchapter C to read as follows:
- 15 SUBCHAPTER C. ELECTRIC PERSONAL ASSISTIVE MOBILITY DEVICES
- Sec. 551.201. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter, "electric
- 17 personal assistive mobility device" means a two non-tandem wheeled
- 18 device designed for transporting one person that is:
- 19 (1) self-balancing; and
- 20 (2) propelled by an electric propulsion system with an
- 21 average power of 750 watts or one horsepower.
- Sec. 551.202. OPERATION ON ROADWAY. (a) A person may
- 23 <u>operate an electric personal assistive mobility device on a roadway</u>
- with a speed limit of 35 miles per hour or less.
- 25 (b) A person may not operate an electric personal assistive
- 26 mobility device on a roadway with a speed limit of more than 35
- 27 miles per hour unless the person operates the device on a part of

- 1 the roadway set aside for the exclusive operation of bicycles.
- 2 (c) A person may not operate an electric personal assistive
- 3 mobility device on a roadway where the operation of bicycles is
- 4 prohibited.
- 5 (d) A person may operate an electric personal assistive
- 6 mobility device on a path set aside for the exclusive operation of
- 7 bicycles.
- 8 <u>(e) Except as otherwise provided by this section,</u>
- 9 provisions of this title applicable to the operation of bicycles
- 10 apply to the operation of electric personal assistive mobility
- 11 devices.
- Sec. 551.203. SIDEWALKS. A person may operate an electric
- 13 personal assistive mobility device on a sidewalk.
- 14 SECTION 6. Section 601.002(5), Transportation Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 (5) "Motor vehicle" means a self-propelled vehicle
- designed for use on a highway, a trailer or semitrailer designed for
- 18 use with a self-propelled vehicle, or a vehicle propelled by
- 19 electric power from overhead wires and not operated on rails. The
- 20 term does not include:
- 21 (A) a traction engine;
- 22 (B) a road roller or grader;
- (C) a tractor crane;
- 24 (D) a power shovel;
- 25 (E) a well driller; [or]
- 26 (F) an implement of husbandry; or
- 27 (G) <u>an electric personal assistive mobility</u>
