6	Sec. 241.029. POLICIES AND PROCEDURES RELATING TO WORKPLACE
7	SAFETY. (a) The governing body of a hospital shall adopt policies
8	and procedures related to the work environment for nurses and other
9	hospital personnel to:
10	(1) improve workplace safety and reduce the risk of
11	injury, occupational illness, and violence; and
12	(2) increase the use of ergonomic principles and
13	ergonomically designed devices to reduce injury and fatigue.
14	(b) The policies and procedures adopted under Subsection
15	(a), at a minimum, must include:
16	(1) evaluating new products and technology that
17	incorporate ergonomic principles;
18	(2) educating hospital personnel in the application of
19	ergonomic practices;
20	(3) conducting workplace audits to identify areas of
21	risk of injury, occupational illness, or violence and recommending
22	ways to reduce those risks;
23	(4) controlling access to those areas identified as
24	having a high risk of violence; and

- 2 <u>hospital personnel to appropriate law enforcement agencies.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003. A
- 4 hospital must adopt policies and procedures required by Section
- 5 241.029, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, not later
- 6 than January 1, 2004.
