S.B. No. 1303

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to certain appointment and employment matters affecting a
3 county auditor, assistant auditor, or court reporter.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 84.004, Local Government Code, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 Sec. 84.004. TERM. The term of office of a county auditor
8 is four [~~two~~] years.

9 SECTION 2. Section 152.905(c), Local Government Code, is
10 amended to read as follows:

11 (c) Not earlier than the 30th or later than the 10th [~~On or~~
12 ~~before the 15th~~] day before the date of the hearing, notice of the
13 time, place, and subject of the hearing must be published in a
14 newspaper of general circulation in the county.

15 SECTION 3. Section 152.032, Local Government Code, is
16 repealed.

17 SECTION 4. (a) The change in law made by this Act to Section
18 84.004, Local Government Code, applies only to a county auditor
19 appointed for a full term beginning on or after the effective date
20 of this Act.

21 (b) The change in law made by this Act to Section
22 152.905(c), Local Government Code, applies only to a hearing that
23 is held on or after the effective date of this Act.

24 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect July 1, 2003, if it

1 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
2 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
3 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for effect on that
4 date, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
