5	SECTION 1. Section 554.001, Occupations Code, is amended by
6	adding a new subsection (e) to read as follows:
7	(e) The Board may establish additional classes of pharmacy
8	licenses if it determines that:
9	(1) the practice setting will provide pharmaceutical
10	<pre>care services to the public;</pre>
11	(2) none of the existing classes of pharmacy licenses
12	are appropriate for the practice setting; and
13	(3) a new class of pharmacy license is necessary to
14	protect the public health, safety, and welfare.
15	SECTION 2. Subsections (a), Section 560.051, Occupations
16	Code is amended as follows:
17	(a) Each applicant for a pharmacy license shall apply for a
18	license in one or more of the following classifications:
19	(1) Class A;
20	(2) Class B;
21	(3) Class C;
22	(4) Class D; or
23	(5) Class E.

- 2 SECTION 2. Section 562.001, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 3 adding a new subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 4 (g) For other Classes of pharmacy licenses created by the
- 5 board under the authority granted in section 554.001, pharmacist
- 6 supervision shall be as designated by board rule. Such supervision
- 7 shall be no less than continuous supervision by a pharmacist
- 8 <u>according to the needs of the pharmacy.</u>
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2001.
