- 2 relating to renewable energy credit for converting solid waste into 3 electric energy.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 363, Health and Safety Code, is amended 6 by adding Subchapter H to read as follows:

7 <u>SUBCHAPTER</u> H. WASTE TO ENERGY

- Sec. 363.171. RENEWABLE ENERGY CREDITS. The Public Utility 8 Commission of Texas by rule may provide for allowing renewable 9 energy credits under the program established under Section 39.904, 10 Utilities Code, for electric generation by any technology that 11 relies wholly or partly on biomass-based products contained in 12 13 municipal solid waste to produce electric energy. The rules must prescribe the amount of credits available and must require that 14 electric generation using the described technology meet or exceed 15 federal and state clean air standards to qualify for the credits. 16
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
