## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- relating to the organization, quorum requirements, and period of service of the directors of certain legislative agencies.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 321.002, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (f) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (e) The committee shall  $\underline{\text{elect}}$  [ $\underline{\text{organize by electing one}}$
- 9 member to serve as chairman and] one member to serve as secretary.
- 10 (f) The lieutenant governor and the speaker serve alternate
- 11 terms as the chairman of the committee. The terms as chairman are
- 12 for two years and expire on February 1 of each odd-numbered year.
- 13 SECTION 2. Subsection (c), Section 321.005, Government
- 14 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 15 (c) The State Auditor serves at the will of the committee
- 16 for a two-year period beginning January 1 of each odd-numbered
- 17 year. The committee shall meet after September 1 and before
- 18 December 31 of each even-numbered year and shall either reappoint
- 19 the State Auditor or appoint another person to serve in that
- 20 position for the following two-year period.
- 21 SECTION 3. Subsection (b), Section 322.001, Government
- 22 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 23 (b) The lieutenant governor [is the chairman of the board]
- 24 and the speaker serve alternate terms as [is] the chairman and

- 1 vice-chairman of the board. The terms as chairman and
- 2 vice-chairman are for two years and expire on February 1 of each
- 3 odd-numbered year.
- 4 SECTION 4. Subsection (a), Section 322.004, Government
- 5 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) The board shall appoint a director to serve at the
- 7 pleasure of the board for a two-year period beginning January 1 of
- 8 each odd-numbered year. The board shall meet after September 1 and
- 9 before December 31 of each even-numbered year and shall either
- 10 reappoint the director or appoint another person to serve in that
- 11 position for the following two-year period. The director is
- 12 accountable only to the board.
- SECTION 5. Subsection (c), Section 323.001, Government
- 14 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 15 (c) The lieutenant governor [is the chairman of the council]
- 16 and the speaker serve alternate terms as [is] the chairman and
- 17 vice-chairman of the council. The terms as chairman and
- 18 vice-chairman are for two years and expire on February 1 of each
- 19 odd-numbered year.
- SECTION 6. Chapter 323, Government Code, is amended by
- 21 adding Section 323.002 to read as follows:
- 22 Sec. 323.002. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR. The council shall
- 23 appoint an executive director to serve at the will of the council
- 24 for a two-year period beginning January 1 of each odd-numbered
- 25 year. The council shall meet after September 1 and before December
- 26 <u>31 of each even-numbered year and shall either reappoint the</u>
- 27 <u>executive director or appoint another person to serve in that</u>

- 1 position for the following two-year period.
- 2 SECTION 7. Subsection (b), Section 323.003, Government
- 3 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (b) A majority of the [Twelve] members of the council from
- 5 each house constitutes [including the chairman and vice chairman
- 6 constitute] a quorum. If a quorum is present, the council may act
- 7 on any matter that is within its jurisdiction by a majority vote.
- 8 SECTION 8. Section 324.004, Government Code, is amended by
- 9 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (e) to read as
- 10 follows:
- 11 (b) The board consists of:
- 12 (1) the lieutenant governor;
- 13 (2) the speaker of the house of representatives;
- 14 (3) two members [the chairman of the senate finance
- 15 committee;
- 16 [(4) the chairman of the house appropriations
- 17 committee;
- 18 [<del>(5) one other member</del>] of the senate appointed by the
- 19 lieutenant governor; and
- 20 (4) two members [<del>(6) one other member</del>] of the house
- 21 appointed by the speaker.
- (e) The lieutenant governor and the speaker serve alternate
- 23 terms as the chairman of the board. The terms as chairman are for
- 24 two years and expire on February 1 of each odd-numbered year.
- 25 SECTION 9. Subsection (a), Section 324.005, Government
- 26 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 27 (a) The board shall appoint a director to serve at the

- 1 pleasure of the board for a two-year period beginning January 1 of
- 2 each odd-numbered year. The board shall meet after September 1 and
- 3 before December 31 of each even-numbered year and shall either
- 4 reappoint the director or appoint another person to serve in that
- 5 position for the following two-year period.
- 6 SECTION 10. Subsection (a), Section 325.004, Government
- 7 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The commission shall employ an executive director to act
- 9 as the executive head of the commission. The executive director
- 10 serves for a two-year period beginning January 1 of each
- 11 odd-numbered year. The commission shall meet after September 1 and
- 12 before December 31 of each even-numbered year and shall either
- 13 reappoint the executive director or appoint another person to serve
- in that position for the following two-year period.
- 15 SECTION 11. (a) To accomplish the alternating
- 16 chairmanship plan for the Legislative Budget Board, the Legislative
- 17 Library Board, the Texas Legislative Council, and the legislative
- 18 audit committee as provided by this Act, on the effective date of
- 19 this Act:
- 20 (1) the lieutenant governor shall assume:
- 21 (A) the chairmanship of the Legislative Budget
- 22 Board;
- 23 (B) the chairmanship of the Legislative Library
- 24 Board; and
- 25 (C) the vice-chairmanship of the Texas
- 26 Legislative Council; and
- 27 (2) the speaker of the house of representatives shall

- 1 assume:
- 2 (A) the chairmanship of the Texas Legislative
- 3 Council;
- 4 (B) the chairmanship of the legislative audit
- 5 committee; and
- 6 (C) the vice-chairmanship of the Legislative
- 7 Budget Board.
- 8 (b) The initial terms of the lieutenant governor and the
- 9 speaker of the house of representatives as chairman and
- 10 vice-chairman, as provided by Subsection (a) of this section,
- 11 expire February 1, 2005.
- 12 (c) The state auditor and the directors of the Legislative
- 13 Budget Board, the Texas Legislative Council, the Legislative
- 14 Reference Library, and the Sunset Advisory Commission who are
- 15 serving on the effective date of this Act:
- 16 (1) may continue to serve for a period ending December
- 17 31, 2004, subject to the will of the governing body of the
- 18 legislative agency; and
- 19 (2) may be reappointed to their positions.
- 20 SECTION 12. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
