- 5 SECTION 1. Article 62.0105(d), Code of Criminal Procedure,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d) After a hearing on the petition described by Subsection
- 8 (a), the court $\frac{\text{shall}}{\text{shall}}$ [may] issue an order exempting the person from
- 9 registration under this chapter if it appears by a preponderance of
- 10 the evidence:
- 11 (1) as presented by a registered sex offender
- 12 treatment provider, that the exemption does not threaten public
- 13 safety; and
- 14 (2) that the person's conduct did not occur without the
- 15 consent of the victim or intended victim as described by Section
- 16 22.011(b), Penal Code.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 18 person subject to registration under Chapter 62, Code of Criminal
- 19 Procedure, for an offense that was committed before, on, or after
- 20 the effective date of this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
