- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6
- 7 SECTION 1. Subsections (a) and (c), Section 4, Article
- 8930, Revised Statutes, are amended to read as follows: 8

- (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, each 9
- project agency shall become self-directed and semi-independent as 10
- specified in this Act. To allow the pilot project the opportunity 11
- 12 to test the effectiveness of operating under the provisions of this
- 13 Act, any Act of the 78th Legislature that relates to an agency
- included in Section 2 of this Act and that is inconsistent with 14
- 15 being self-directed and semi-independent may be implemented on
- authorization by the governing board of the agency. 16
- This Act is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code 17
- (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by 18
- that chapter, this Act expires September 1, 2009 [2003]. 19
- SECTION 2. Subsection (c), Section 6, Article 8930, Revised 20
- Statutes, is amended to read as follows: 21
- 22 The Texas State Board of Public Accountancy shall
- 23 annually remit \$703,344 [\$500,000] to the general revenue fund, the
- 24 Texas Board of Professional Engineers shall annually remit \$373,900

- 1 [\$50,000] to the general revenue fund, and the Texas Board of

- 4 SECTION 3. Section 14, Article 8930, Revised Statutes, is
- 5 amended by adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:
- 6 (c) A project agency may retain each fiscal year an amount
- of fines and other revenue the project agency receives during the
- 8 fiscal year as a result of enforcement actions that is equal to 20
- 9 percent of the total amount expended by the project agency during
- 10 the previous fiscal year, not to exceed \$1 million.
- 11 (d) At the end of each fiscal year 50 percent of the
- 12 unexpended balance of the amount retained in Subsection (c) of this
- 13 section shall be deposited to the credit of the general revenue

- 15 SECTION 4. Article 8930, Revised Statutes, is amended by
- 16 adding Section 18 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 18. GIFTS. (a) Notwithstanding other law, a project
- 18 agency may not accept a gift, grant, or donation:
- 19 (1) from a party to an enforcement action; or
- 20 (2) to pursue a specific investigation or enforcement
- 21 action.
- (b) A project agency must:
- 23 (1) report each gift, grant, or donation that the
- 24 agency receives as a separate item in the agency's detailed report
- 25 under Section 8(b) of this Act; and
- 26 (2) include with the report a statement indicating the
- 27 purpose for which each gift, grant, or donation was used.

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1 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
