## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to regulation of distressed devices.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Chapter 432, Health and Safety Code, is amended
5	by adding Section 432.0045 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 432.0045. INAPPLICABILITY TO CERTAIN TRANSFERS.
7	(a) In this section, "hospital" means a public or private hospital
8	licensed under Chapter 241 and a hospital owned or operated by the
9	state.
10	(b) Subject to Subsection (c), this chapter does not apply
11	to the transfer of a distressed device:
12	(1) from a person licensed under this chapter to a
13	hospital; or
14	(2) from a hospital to another hospital.
15	(c) A person, including a hospital, making a transfer under
16	Subsection (b) must provide an appropriate disclosure regarding the
17	condition of the distressed device to the recipient of the
18	distressed device. For the purposes of this section, "appropriate
19	disclosure" means a concise written statement that:
20	(1) is dated;
21	(2) contains the name of the transferring person; and
22	(3) describes the condition of the distressed device,
23	if known, or if unknown, states that the device may not meet
24	manufacturer's specifications. The statement must include the

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1	following, "Prior to use, a distressed device that does not meet the
2	manufacturer's specifications must be reconditioned."

3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
