A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to requiring the Texas State Library and Archives
3	Commission and the Department of Information Resources to establish
4	a searchable database for grants awarded by state agencies.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 441, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 441.010 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 441.010. ELECTRONICALLY SEARCHABLE CENTRAL GRANT
9	DATABASE. (a) In this section:
10	(1) "Department" means the Department of Information
11	Resources.
12	(2) "Grant" means a grant, contract, or other
13	cooperative agreement under which a state agency awards financial
14	assistance in the form of money, property, a loan, or another thing
15	of value to a governmental or nongovernmental entity and the
16	governmental or nongovernmental entity receiving the award is
17	responsible for implementing a state or federal program in
18	accordance with guidelines provided by the agency awarding the
19	grant. The term does not include a contract to obtain a
20	professional or consulting service subject to Chapter 2254.
21	(b) The commission, in cooperation with the department,
22	shall establish an electronically searchable central database
23	accessible through the commission's on-line access system that will
24	allow a person to:

1	(1) use keyword searches to discover all available
2	state agency grant opportunities;
3	(2) obtain basic information regarding each available
4	state agency grant opportunity, including basic information about
5	the program that the grant recipient will implement, the geographic
6	area in which the grant recipient will implement the program, the
7	eligibility requirements for obtaining the grant, and the grant
8	application process; and
9	(3) electronically link to the portion of the granting
10	agency's website at which the person may obtain more detailed
11	information about each available state agency grant opportunity.
12	(c) The department shall provide a link on TexasOnline to
13	the database established under Subsection (b). In this subsection,
14	"TexasOnline" has the meaning assigned by Section 2054.003.
15	(d) Each state agency that will award a grant shall,
16	concurrently with any other action the agency takes to inform the
17	public or any person about the grant opportunity, report to the
18	commission information related to the grant that the commission
19	requires in a form prescribed by the commission so that the
20	commission may include information about the grant in the
21	electronically searchable central database established under
22	Subsection (b).
23	(e) The governor shall appoint an advisory committee
24	composed of nine representatives from the Electronic Grants
25	Technical Assistance Workgroup to:
26	(1) gather input from public and other users of the

1	(2) advise the commission regarding the development of
2	the database and regarding the commission's exercise of its powers
3	under Subsection (d).
4	(f) The advisory committee appointed under Subsection (e)
5	shall meet in Austin. A state agency that is represented on the
6	committee by a person who is not based in the Austin area is
7	responsible for any travel expenses incurred by its representative.
8	(g) The commission shall appoint an advisory committee
9	composed of five public members to annually evaluate the operation
10	of the electronically searchable central database.
11	(h) Chapter 2110 does not apply to an advisory committee
12	formed under this section.
13	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
14	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
15	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
16	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

17 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
