A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2	relating to requiring the Department of Information Resources to
3	establish an electronically searchable central database for all
4	grants that will be awarded by a state agency.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 2054, Government Code, is

amended by adding Section 2054.065 to read as follows:

- Sec. 2054.065. ELECTRONICALLY SEARCHABLE CENTRAL GRANT DATABASE. (a) In this section, "grant" means a grant, contract, or cooperative agreement under which a state agency awards financial assistance in the form of money, property, a loan, or another thing of value to a governmental or nongovernmental entity and the governmental or nongovernmental entity receiving the award is responsible for implementing a state or federal program in accordance with guidelines provided by the agency awarding the grant. The term does not include a contract to obtain a professional or consulting service subject to Chapter 2254.
- 18 <u>(b) The department shall establish an electronically</u>
 19 <u>searchable central database accessible through TexasOnline that</u>
 20 will allow a person to:
- 21 (1) use keyword searches to discover all available 22 state agency grant opportunities;
- 23 (2) obtain basic information regarding each available 24 state agency grant opportunity, including basic information about

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- 1 the program that the grant recipient will implement, the geographic
- 2 area in which the grant recipient will implement the program, the
- 3 eligibility requirements for obtaining the grant, and the grant
- 4 application process; and
- 5 (3) electronically link to the portion of the granting
- 6 agency's website at which the person may obtain more detailed
- 7 <u>information about each available state agency grant opportunity.</u>
- 8 (c) Each state agency that will award a grant shall,
- 9 concurrently with any other action the agency takes to inform the
- 10 public or any person about the grant opportunity, report to the
- 11 department information related to the grant that the department
- 12 requires in a form prescribed by the department so that the
- 13 department may include information about the grant in the
- 14 electronically searchable central database in accordance with
- 15 Subsection (b).
- 16 (d) The department and the office of the governor jointly
- 17 shall appoint an advisory committee composed of representatives of
- 18 nine state agencies to advise the department regarding the
- 19 development of the electronically searchable central database and
- 20 regarding the department's exercise of its powers under Subsection
- 21 (c). The department shall perform the duties imposed by Sections
- 22 2110.005-2110.008 regarding the advisory committee. The advisory
- 23 committee shall meet in Austin. A state agency that is represented
- on the committee by a person who is not based in the Austin area is
- 25 responsible for any travel expenses incurred by its representative.
- 26 (e) The department and the office of the governor jointly
- 27 shall appoint an advisory committee composed of five public members

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- 1 to annually evaluate the operation of the electronically searchable
- 2 central database. The department shall perform the duties imposed
- 3 by Sections 2110.004-2110.008 regarding the advisory committee.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
