## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. The following provisions of the Agriculture Code
6	are repealed:
7	(1) Sections 12.004, 12.008, 12.009, 12.030, 13.005,
8	13.006, 13.103, 13.105, 13.106, 13.107, 13.108(b) and (c), 15.004,
9	77.004, and 77.005; and
10	(2) Chapters 53, 96, 104, 145, and 252.
11	SECTION 2. Section 13.109, Agriculture Code, is amended to
12	read as follows:
13	Sec. 13.109. RULES GOVERNING SEALERS. The department shall
14	issue instructions and adopt rules governing state[ <del>, county, and</del>
15	local] sealers as necessary to carry out the purposes of this
16	chapter.
17	SECTION 3. Subsection (a), Section 13.110, Agriculture
18	Code, is amended to read as follows:
19	(a) In accordance with this subchapter, each sealer may
20	inspect and test all weights and measures used in the locality to
21	which the sealer is assigned [ <del>or in the city or county in which the</del>
22	<pre>sealer is appointed].</pre>
23	SECTION 4. Section 13.122, Agriculture Code, is amended to
24	read as follows:

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Sec. 13.122. PENALTIES. An offense under Section [13.103,
13.106, ] 13.114[, ] or each of Sections 13.116 through 13.121 [of
this code] is a Class C misdemeanor.

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4 SECTION 5. The farm and ranch loan security fund created 5 under Section 252.081, Agriculture Code, is abolished.

6 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

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
