- 9 (a) A contractor who performs the construction or repair of
- 10 any highway, road or street for any governmental unit is not liable
- 11 for personal injury, property damage, or death to third parties
- 12 resulting from or arising out of the performance of or any failure
- 13 to perform the construction or repair if, at the time of such
- 14 personal injury, property damage or death, the contractor is in
- 15 substantial compliance with all specifications for such
- 16 construction or repair required by the contracting governmental
- 17 unit.
- 18 (b) A contractor who performs the construction or repair of
- any highway, road or street for any governmental unit may be liable
- 20 for personal injury, property damage, or death to third parties
- 21 resulting from or arising out of the performance of or any failure

- 1 construction or repair required by the contracting governmental

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and applies to a cause of action that accrues on or after that date. An action that accrued before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the time the action accrued, and that law in continued in effect for that purpose.
