1-12 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-13 AN ACT

1-14 relating to federal matching funds for certain projects at military
1-15 facilities in this state.

1-16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-17 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 431, Government Code, is
1-18 amended by adding Section 431.017 to read as follows:

1-19 Sec. 431.017. MILITARY FACILITIES PROJECTS: MATCHING
1-20 FEDERAL FUNDS. (a) The Military Facilities Funding Board is
1-21 composed of:

1-22 (1) the governor;

1-23 (2) the lieutenant governor;

1-24 (3) the adjutant general; and

1-25 (4) the executive director of the Texas Military
1-26 Facilities Commission.

1-27 (b) If the governor finds that the state is eligible for
1-28 federal matching funds for projects at military facilities in this
1-29 state, the governor with the concurrence of the Military Facilities
1-30 Funding Board may direct that money appropriated for the purpose be
1-31 used to obtain the federal matching funds.

1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

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
