9	school nurse is entitled to a monthly salary that is at least equal

12	(A) the monthly salary the employee would have
13	received for the 2003-2004 or 2004-2005 school year, as applicable,
14	under the district's salary schedule for the 2002-2003 school year,
15	if that schedule had been in effect for the 2003-2004 or 2004-2005
16	school year, including any local supplement and any money
17	representing a career ladder supplement the employee would have
18	received in the 2003-2004 or 2004-2005 school year; and
19	(B) \$500; or
20	(2) the salary to which the employee is entitled under
21	Subsection (a).
22	(c-2) Subsection (c-1) and this subsection expire September

24	SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2003-2004
