9	department chief or chief executive of a fire department or an
10	emergency medical services provider for an unincorporated area, a
11	county fire marshal is entitled to obtain from the department
12	criminal history record information maintained by the department
13	that relates to:
14	(1) an applicant for employment or membership with the
15	requesting department or provider; or
16	(2) an employee or member of the requesting department
17	<u>or provider.</u>
18	(b) The county fire marshal may disclose criminal history
19	record information obtained under Subsection (a) to the department
20	chief or chief executive of the requesting fire department or
21	emergency medical services provider, except that the county fire
22	marshal may disclose criminal history record information obtained
23	by the department from the Federal Bureau of Investigation only to
24	governmental entities or as authorized by federal law, federal
