8 INFORMATION: COUNTY FIRE MARSHALS. (a) On request of the

department chief or chief executive of a fire department or an

emergency medical services provider for an unincorporated area of a

11 county, a county fire marshal is entitled to obtain criminal

history record information that relates to an employee or member of

13 <u>the requesting department or provider.</u>

14 (b) The county fire marshal may disclose the criminal

15 history record information to the department chief or chief

16 executive of the requesting fire department or emergency medical

17 services provider.
