5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 352, Local Government
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 352.006 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 352.006. SALE OF USED FIRE PROTECTION OR FIRE-FIGHTING
8	EQUIPMENT TO CERTAIN VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENTS. (a) In this
9	section, "volunteer fire department" means an association that:
10	(1) operates fire-fighting equipment;
11	(2) is organized primarily to provide and actively
12	<pre>provides fire-fighting services;</pre>
13	(3) does not pay its members compensation other than
14	nominal compensation; and
15	(4) does not distribute any of its income to its
16	members, officers, or governing body, other than for reimbursement
17	of expenses.
18	(b) Notwithstanding Subchapter D, Chapter 263, or other
19	law, the commissioners court of a county may sell used
20	fire-fighting equipment, excluding equipment described in Sections
21	419.040 and 419.041, Government Code, to a volunteer fire
22	department for eight percent of the original purchase value of the
23	equipment if:
24	(1) the fire protection or fire-fighting equipment is

- 1 at least 15 years old and met the National Fire Protection
- 2 Association standards at the original time of purchase; and
- 3 (2) the volunteer fire department provides fire
- 4 protection to an area within the county.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
