- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 392.067 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 392.067. COMMUNITY SERVICE REQUIREMENT. (a) In this
- 8 section, "school-age child" means a child who is at least five years
- 9 of age but younger than 14 years of age.
- 10 (b) Each housing authority shall adopt rules requiring that
- 11 a public housing resident devote to the educational needs of at
- 12 least one school-age child of that resident one or more hours of
- 13 community service of the eight total hours of community service
- 14 that the resident is required to contribute each month under 42
- U.S.C. <u>Section 1437j(c)</u>. The authority shall establish procedures
- 16 for verifying compliance with the community service education
- 17 requirement imposed under this subsection.
- 18 (c) The following public housing residents are exempt from
- 19 the community service education requirement imposed under
- 20 Subsection (b):
- 21 (1) a resident who is not a parent, conservator, or
- 22 <u>other guardian of a school-age child;</u>

- 1 for eight hours each month; and
- 2 (3) a resident who is exempt from the community
- 3 service requirement under 42 U.S.C. Section 1437j(c)(2).
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
