4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 814.107(b), Government Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	(b) The standard service retirement annuity payable for at
8	least 20 years of service credit as a law enforcement or custodial
9	officer is an amount computed on the basis of the member's average
10	monthly compensation for that service for the 36 highest months of
11	compensation, times the sum of the percentage factor used in the
12	computation of a standard service retirement annuity under Section
13	814.105 plus <u>:</u>
14	(1) .5 percent for service credit as a custodial
15	<u>officer;</u>
16	(2) .5 percent for service credit as a law enforcement
17	officer, unless the member qualifies under Subdivision (3); or
18	(3) .75 percent for service credit as a law
19	enforcement officer, if the total amount of law enforcement service
20	credited is 30 years or more and at least three years of that
21	service occurs after August 31, 2003.
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
