1-6 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the retirement benefits of certain law enforcement  
1-9 officers in the Employees Retirement System of Texas.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 814.107, Government  
1-12 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-13 (b) The standard service retirement annuity payable for at  
1-14 least 20 years of service credit as a law enforcement or custodial  
1-15 officer is an amount computed on the basis of the member's average  
1-16 monthly compensation for that service for the 36 highest months of  
1-17 compensation [~~in the employee class~~], times the sum of the  
1-18 percentage factor used in the computation of a standard service  
1-19 retirement annuity under Section 814.105 plus:

1-20 (1) .5 percent for service credit as a custodial  
1-21 officer;

1-22 (2) .5 percent for service credit as a law enforcement  
1-23 officer, unless the member qualifies under Subdivision (3); or

1-24 (3) .75 percent for service credit as a law  
1-25 enforcement officer, if the total amount of law enforcement service  
1-26 credited is 30 years or more and at least three years of that  
1-27 service occurs after August 31, 2003.

1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
