- 6 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 91.114, Natural
- 7 Resources Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (d), the commission may
- 9 not accept an organization report required under Section 91.142 or
- 10 an application for a permit under this Chapter, Chapter 85, or
- 11 Chapter 26, 27, or 29, Water Code, or approve a certificate of
- 12 compliance under Section 85.161 if:
- 13 (1) the organization that submitted the report,
- 14 application, or certificate violated a statute or commission rule,
- order, license, certificate, or permit that relates to safety or
- 16 the prevention or control of pollution; or
- 17 (2) a person who holds a position of ownership or
- 18 control in the organization has, within the seven [five] years
- 19 preceding the date on which the report, application, or certificate
- 20 is filed, held a position of ownership or control in another
- 21 organization and during that period of ownership or control the
- 22 other organization violated a statute or commission rule, order,
- 23 license, permit, or certificate that relates to safety or the
- 24 prevention or control of pollution.

- 1 SECTION 2. (a) This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 2 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 3 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 4 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 5 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
- 6 (b) The change in law made by this Act applies only to an
- 7 organization report, permit application, or request for
- 8 certificate of compliance that is filed with the Railroad
- 9 Commission of Texas on or after the effective date of this Act.
