A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the land application of certain sludge. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 361.121(a)(3), Health and Safety Code, 4 5 is amended to read as follows: the person 6 (3) "Responsible person" means with ultimate responsibility for the land application of the sewage 7 [Class B] sludge at a land application unit. The responsible person 8 9 is: (A) the owner of the land application unit if the 10 sludge being land applied was generated outside this state; or 11 12 (B) the person who is land applying the sludge if 13 the sludge being land applied was generated in this state. 14 SECTION 2. Sections 361.121(b) and (d), Health and Safety Code, are amended to read as follows: 15 16 (b) A responsible person may not apply <u>sewage</u> [Class B] sludge on a land application unit unless: 17 18 (1) the sludge has been disinfected to a high degree; 19 and (2) the responsible person has obtained a permit for 20 21 that land application unit issued by the commission under this section on or after September 1, 2003. 22 In each permit, the commission shall prescribe the 23 (d) conditions under which it is issued, including: 24

1 (1) the duration of the permit; 2 (2) the location of the land application unit; 3 the maximum quantity of sewage [Class B] sludge (3) 4 that may be applied or disposed of under the permit; 5 (4) any monitoring and reporting requirements 6 prescribed by the commission for the permit holder; and 7 a requirement that the permit holder must report (5) 8 to the commission any noncompliance by the permit holder with the permit conditions or applicable commission rules. 9 SECTION 3. Sections 361.121(a)(1) and (i), Health 10 and Safety Code, are repealed. 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003, and 12 applies only to sludge applied on a land application unit on or 13 after that date. Sludge applied on a land application unit before 14

15 the effective date of this Act is covered by the law in effect on the 16 date the sludge is applied, and the former law is continued in 17 effect for that purpose.
