BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 1-12 SECTION 1. Subsection (g), Section 54.008, Education Code,

1-13 is amended to read as follows: (g) The governing board of an institution of higher education shall set tuition for a law school <u>or a graduate school of</u> <u>business</u> at the institution at a rate that is at least equal to the 1-14 1**-**15 1**-**16 1-17 rate prescribed by Subchapter B but not more than three times the

rate prescribed by Subchapter B. SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with tuition charges 1-18 1-19 imposed for the fall semester of 2003.

1-20 1-21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-24 1-25 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
