5 SECTION 1. Section 54.0513(b), Education Code, is amended

Section 54.0513(b) In addition to amounts that a governing board of an institution of higher education is authorized to charge as tuition under the other provisions of this chapter, the governing board is authorized to charge as <u>designated</u> tuition in an academic year an amount not to exceed <u>three times</u> that amount charged under Sections 54.051 or 54.0512, as applicable, in that academic year. <u>Under this section</u>, a governing body may set a <u>different tuition rate for each program offered by each institution</u>

of higher education. A governing board may also set a different

16 <u>tuition rate to increase graduation rates, to encourage efficient</u>

facilities utilization and to enhance employee performance.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, the

22 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
