## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the limitation on a laboratory charge that may be set by

3 a public junior college.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 54.501(a), Education Code, is amended to

6 read as follows:

- 7 (a) An institution of higher education shall set and collect
- 8 a laboratory charge in an amount sufficient to cover in general the
- 9 cost of laboratory materials and supplies used by a student. For an
- 10 institution other than a public junior college, the laboratory
- 11 charge shall be not less than \$2 nor more than \$30 for any one
- 12 semester or summer term for any student in any one laboratory
- 13 course, but shall not exceed the cost of actual materials and
- 14 supplies used by the student. For a public junior college, the
- 15 laboratory charge shall [be not more than \$24 for any one semester
- 16 or summer term for any student in any one laboratory course, but
- 17 shall] not exceed the cost of actual materials and supplies used by
- 18 the student.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
