1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to the creation and composition of judicial districts and  
1-10 the election and powers and duties of certain district attorneys.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. (a) Subchapter C, Chapter 24, Government Code,  
1-13 is amended by adding Section 24.557 to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 24.557. 413TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT (JOHNSON COUNTY). The  
1-15 413th Judicial District is composed of Johnson County.

1-16 (b) The 413th Judicial District is created and this section  
1-17 takes effect September 1, 2005.

1-18 SECTION 2. (a) Subchapter C, Chapter 24, Government Code,  
1-19 is amended by adding Section 24.558 to read as follows:

1-20 Sec. 24.558. 414TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT (MCLENNAN COUNTY).  
1-21 The 414th Judicial District is composed of McLennan County.

1-22 (b) The 414th Judicial District is created and this section  
1-23 takes effect September 1, 2005.

1-24 SECTION 3. (a) Subchapter C, Chapter 24, Government Code,  
1-25 is amended by adding Section 24.559 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 24.559. 415TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT (PARKER COUNTY). The  
1-27 415th Judicial District is composed of Parker County.

1-28 (b) Subsection (a), Section 32.184, Government Code, is  
1-29 amended to read as follows:

1-30 (a) The Commissioners Court of Parker County may budget for  
1-31 and pay the judges [judge] of the 43rd and 415th judicial districts  
1-32 [~~Judicial District~~] an annual salary not to exceed \$7,800 for  
1-33 performing judicial and administrative services.

1-34 (c) Section 43.125, Government Code, is amended to read as  
1-35 follows:

1-36 Sec. 43.125. 43RD JUDICIAL DISTRICT. The voters of the 43rd  
1-37 Judicial District elect a district attorney who represents the  
1-38 state in all cases before the 43rd and 415th district courts.

1-39 (d) Subsection (b), Section 152.1901, Human Resources Code,  
1-40 is amended to read as follows:

1-41 (b) The [~~district court~~] judge of the 43rd Judicial District  
1-42 is the chairman of the board.

1-43 (e) The 415th Judicial District is created and this section  
1-44 takes effect September 1, 2005.

1-45 SECTION 4. (a) Subchapter C, Chapter 24, Government Code,  
1-46 is amended by adding Sections 24.560 and 24.561 to read as follows:

1-47 Sec. 24.560. 416TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT (COLLIN COUNTY). The  
1-48 416th Judicial District is composed of Collin County.

1-49 Sec. 24.561. 417TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT (COLLIN COUNTY).  
1-50 (a) The 417th Judicial District is composed of Collin County.

1-51 (b) The 417th District Court shall give preference to  
1-52 juvenile matters.

1-53 (b) Subchapter C, Chapter 24, Government Code, is amended by  
1-54 adding Section 24.562 to read as follows:

1-55 Sec. 24.562. 418TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT (COLLIN COUNTY). The  
1-56 418th Judicial District is composed of Collin County.

1-57 (c) The 416th, 417th, and 418th judicial districts are  
1-58 created and this section takes effect September 1, 2005.

1-59 SECTION 5. (a) Subchapter C, Chapter 24, Government Code,  
1-60 is amended by adding Section 24.563 to read as follows:

1-61 Sec. 24.563. 419TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT (TRAVIS COUNTY). The  
1-62 419th Judicial District is composed of Travis County.

1-63 (b) The 419th Judicial District is created and this section

2-1 takes effect September 1, 2005.

2-2 SECTION 6. (a) Subchapter C, Chapter 24, Government Code,  
2-3 is amended by adding Section 24.564 to read as follows:

2-4 Sec. 24.564. 420TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT (NACOGDOCHES COUNTY).  
2-5 The 420th Judicial District is composed of Nacogdoches County.

2-6 (b) The 420th Judicial District is created and this section  
2-7 takes effect September 1, 2005.

2-8 SECTION 7. (a) Subchapter C, Chapter 24, Government Code,  
2-9 is amended by adding Section 24.565 to read as follows:

2-10 Sec. 24.565. 421ST JUDICIAL DISTRICT (CALDWELL COUNTY).  
2-11 The 421st Judicial District is composed of Caldwell County.

2-12 (b) The 421st Judicial District is created and this section  
2-13 takes effect September 1, 2005.

2-14 SECTION 8. (a) Subchapter C, Chapter 24, Government Code,  
2-15 is amended by adding Section 24.566 to read as follows:

2-16 Sec. 24.566. 422ND JUDICIAL DISTRICT (KAUFMAN COUNTY). The  
2-17 422nd Judicial District is composed of Kaufman County.

2-18 (b) The 422nd Judicial District is created and this section  
2-19 takes effect September 1, 2005.

2-20 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
