A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to certain administrative penalties assessed by the Texas 3 Department of Health. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 485.101(a), Health and Safety Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 The department may impose an administrative penalty on a 7 (a) person who sells abusable volatile chemicals [glue or aerosol 8 paint] at retail who violates this chapter or a rule or order 9 adopted under this chapter. 10 SECTION 2. Section 485.102(a), Health and Safety Code, is 11 12 amended to read as follows: 13 (a) The amount of the penalty may not exceed \$5,000 [\$1,000] 14 for each violation, and each day a violation continues or occurs is a separate violation for purposes of imposing a penalty. The total 15 amount of the penalty assessed for a violation continuing or 16 occurring on separate days under this subsection may not exceed 17 18 <u>\$25,000</u> [\$5,000]. SECTION 3. Section 501.102(a), Health and Safety Code, is 19 amended to read as follows: 20 21 (a) The amount of the penalty may not exceed \$10,000 22 [\$1,000] for each violation, and each day a violation continues or occurs is a separate violation for purposes of imposing a penalty. 23 [The total amount of the penalty assessed for a violation 24

1 continuing or occurring on separate days under this subsection may
2 not exceed \$5,000.]

3 SECTION 4. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies 4 only to a violation committed on or after the effective date of this 5 Act. For purposes of this section, a violation is committed before 6 the effective date of this Act if any element of the violation 7 occurs before that date.

8 (b) A violation committed before the effective date of this 9 Act is covered by the law in effect when the violation was 10 committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that 11 purpose.
