## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to facilities outside of a county seat.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 292.002(a), Local Government Code, is 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 292.002. FACILITIES OUTSIDE COUNTY SEAT. (a) The 7 commissioners court of a county may provide an office building or a
- 8 jail facility at a location in the county outside the county seat in
- 9 the same manner that is applicable to such a building or facility at 10 the county seat. The commissioners court may provide for the
- 11 building or facility through the issuance of bonds as provided by
- 12 Subtitles A, C, and D, Title 9, Government Code, or through the
- issuance of other evidences of indebtedness in the same manner as
- 14 bonds or evidences of indebtedness applicable to a courthouse or
- 15 jail at the county seat. The commissioners court may provide office
- space in the building or facility for any county or precinct office
- 17 except a court required by law to sit at the county seat. However,
  18 except as provided by subsection (b), a county officer who is
- 19 provided space in the building or facility shall maintain an office
- 20 at the county seat and shall keep the original records of office at
- 21 that office.
- (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the [The]
- 23 commissioners court may authorize places located in the county but
- outside the municipality designated as the county seat as auxiliary

- 1 courts for the holding of court proceedings in any courts including
- 2 <u>district courts</u> and may designate those places as auxiliary county
- 3 seats for this purpose. The records of any court sitting in an
- 4 auxiliary county seat, including the records of the clerk of the
- 5 court, may be kept in the auxiliary county seat.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
