## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the regulation of dental laboratories and dental
3	technicians.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 266.002, Occupations Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	Sec. 266.002. EXEMPTIONS. This chapter does not apply to:
8	(1) a student enrolled in a program of a school of
9	dentistry; [ <del>or</del> ]
10	(2) a licensed dentist engaged in the practice of
11	dentistry in this state who performs a dental laboratory service
12	for compensation or an employee of the dentist or of the
13	professional corporation or partnership in which the dentist is an
14	officer, partner, or employee if the service is performed:
15	(A) for a patient of the dentist or of the
16	professional corporation or partnership in which the dentist is an
17	officer, partner, or employee; and
18	(B) on the premises in which the dentist
19	practices dentistry; or
20	(3) a manufacturer of materials or component parts,
21	used in the fabrication of a dental prosthetic appliance and for
22	sale or use by a dental laboratory, that are not directly fitted to
23	a dental model or cast of the human teeth, gums, jaws, or alveolar
24	process.

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SECTION 2. Subsection (c), Section 266.102, Occupations
 Code, is amended to read as follows:

3 (c) In prescribing the content of continuing education 4 courses under Subsection (b)(4), the board shall require the course 5 content to be at least as comprehensive as a course approved by a 6 [nationally] recognized board of certification for dental 7 technology.

8 SECTION 3. Subsection (a), Section 266.152, Occupations 9 Code, is amended to read as follows:

10 (a) A dental laboratory must have at least one dental 11 technician working on the laboratory's premises who is certified by 12 a [nationally] recognized board of certification for dental 13 technology.

SECTION 4. Subsection (b), Section 266.153, Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows:

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(b) The application must include:

17 (1) evidence satisfactory to the board that the dental
18 laboratory meets the requirements prescribed by Section
19 266.152(a), if applicable; <u>and</u>

20 (2) [the name and address of each dental technician
21 employed by the dental laboratory; and

[(3)] any other information required by the board.
 SECTION 5. Subsection (b), Section 266.201, Occupations
 Code, is amended to read as follows:

(b) The prescription or work order must contain:
(1) the signature and Texas dental license number of
the dentist;

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1	(2)	the date the prescription or work order is signed	;
2	(3)	the patient's name [ <del>and address</del> ]; and	
3	(4)	a description of the dental laboratory servi	ce
4	ordered.		
5	SECTION 6	This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.	

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
