1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to workers' compensation treatment guidelines and
1-10 protocols.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 413.011, Labor Code, is
1-13 amended to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 413.011. REIMBURSEMENT POLICIES AND GUIDELINES;
1-15 TREATMENT GUIDELINES AND PROTOCOLS.

1-16 SECTION 2. Subsections (e) and (f), Section 413.011, Labor
1-17 Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-18 (e) The commission by rule may adopt treatment guidelines,
1-19 including return-to-work guidelines, and individual treatment
1-20 protocols. Except as otherwise provided by this subsection [If
1-21 adopted], the treatment guidelines and protocols [adopted] must be
1-22 nationally recognized, scientifically valid, and outcome-based and
1-23 designed to reduce excessive or inappropriate medical care while
1-24 safeguarding necessary medical care. If a nationally recognized
1-25 treatment guideline or protocol is not available for adoption by
1-26 the commission, the commission may adopt another treatment
1-27 guideline or protocol as long as it is scientifically valid and
1-28 outcome-based.

1-29 (f) The commission by rule may establish medical policies or
1-30 treatment guidelines or protocols relating to necessary treatments
1-31 for injuries.

1-32 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-33 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-34 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-35 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-36 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
