12	person acts without malice and in the reasonable belief that the
13	action or recommendation is warranted by the facts known to that
14	person. In the event of a civil action brought against a member of
15	the panel that arises from the person's participation on the panel,
16	the person [in good faith as a member of the panel and] is entitled
17	to the same protections afforded a commission member under Section
18	402.010.
19	SECTION 2. Subsection (d), Section 413.0512, Labor Code, as

amended by this Act, applies to a member of the medical quality review panel regardless of whether the person is a member of the panel at the time the action is brought.
