1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to bureau of vital statistics forms.

1-9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-10 SECTION 1. Section 192.009, Health and Safety Code, is  
1-11 amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

1-12 (d) Certificates submitted to the state registrar by the  
1-13 clerk of the court which need correction shall be mailed directly  
1-14 from the bureau of vital statistics to the attorney of record  
1-15 designated on the certificate.

1-16 SECTION 2. Section 194.002, Health and Safety Code, is  
1-17 amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:

1-18 (f) Forms submitted to the bureau of vital statistics by the  
1-19 clerk of the court which need correction shall be mailed directly  
1-20 from the bureau of vital statistics to the attorney of record  
1-21 designated on the certificate.

1-22 SECTION 3. Section 108.003, Family Code, is amended by  
1-23 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

1-24 (c) Forms submitted to the bureau of vital statistics shall  
1-25 be mailed directly from the bureau of vital statistics to the  
1-26 attorney of record as designated on the bureau of vital statistics  
1-27 form.

1-28 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.

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
