13	(1) clearly describe the circumstances in which a
14	peace officer of the law enforcement agency is authorized by the law
15	enforcement agency to make a warrantless custodial arrest of a
16	person for a misdemeanor offense that is punishable by fine only;
17	and
18	(2) provide for a review of each warrantless custodial
19	arrest of a person for a misdemeanor offense that is punishable by
20	fine only by the immediate supervisor, if any, of the officer making
21	the arrest.
22	(c) Article 38.23 does not apply to evidence arising out of
23	an arrest made in violation of a policy adopted under Subsection (a)
24	or where an arrest is made in the absence of a policy required to be

1 adopted by this article.

2 SECTION 2. A law enforcement agency required by Article 3 14.07, Code of Criminal Procedure, as added by this Act, to adopt an 4 arrest policy shall adopt the policy not later than January 1, 2004. 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
