7	Section 31.009. Distribution of Unclaimed Class Settlement
8	or Judgment Funds. (a) In any action certified pursuant to Rule
9	42, Texas Rules of Civil Procedure, in which the settlement or
10	judgment includes a monetary award (by way of damages, equitable
11	restitution, or other payment due from each defendant to the class,

- 12 prior to the entry of the settlement or judgment the court shall set
- a date when the parties shall report to the court the total amount
 of all funds paid to the class members. After the report is
- 15 received, the court shall amend the settlement or judgment to
- 16 direct each defendant to pay the sum of any unpaid funds to the
- 17 clerk of the court.
- 18 (b) Within 30 days of receiving funds under this section,
- 19 the clerk of the court shall pay the funds to the clerk of the
- 20 supreme court. Funds received under this section shall be
- 21 distributed to programs approved by the supreme court that provide
- 22 civil legal services to the indigent.
- (c) Funds received under this section are not subject to the
- provisions of section 31.008.
