## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the membership fee collected by the supreme court from
- 3 members of the state bar.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 81.054, Government Code, is amended by 6 adding subsection (f) as follows:
- 7 (f) The fees set by the supreme court in subsection (a) shall include a fee of not less than \$65.00 for the provision of 8 civil legal services to the indigent. Fees collected under this 9 10 subsection shall be distributed to programs approved by the supreme court that provide civil legal services to the indigent. The 11 supreme court shall annually review the membership fee to determine 12 13 whether the fee is sufficient to support the needs of indigent 14 individuals unable to obtain judicial access and related legal 15 services. In conducting its annual review, the supreme court shall review recommendations of the Texas Access to Justice Commission 16 regarding priority unmet legal needs that restrict access to 17
- 18 justice for indigent persons.
- 19 SECTION 2. This act takes effect September 1, 2003.
