4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 31, Natural Resources
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 31.0655 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 31.0655. STATE EMPLOYEE CONTRIBUTIONS TO
8	ADOPT-A-MAP/ADOPT-A-DOCUMENT PROGRAM. For purposes of Subchapter
9	I, Chapter 659, Government Code:
10	(1) the land office, for the sole purpose of managing
11	the Adopt-A-Map/Adopt-A-Document Program, is considered an
12	eligible charitable organization entitled to participate in the
13	state employee charitable campaign; and
14	(2) a state employee is entitled to authorize a
15	deduction for contributions to the land office for the purposes of
16	managing the Adopt-A-Map/Adopt-A-Document Program as a charitable
17	contribution under Section 659.132, Government Code, and the land
18	office may use the contributions for the purpose of preserving
19	historic maps and documents under that program.
20	SECTION 2. The General Land Office is entitled to
21	participate in the state employee charitable campaign conducted
22	during the autumn of 2003 without regard to any limitation on the
23	time during which an organization must apply to participate in the
24	campaign.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
