12	(b) In a suit filed under this article, a plaintiff who

14	(1) the amount of economic damages plus court costs
15	and attorneys' fees. Court costs may include any reasonable and
16	necessary expert witness fees. If the trier of fact finds that the
17	defendant knowingly committed any acts prohibited by this article,
18	the court may award a civil penalty in an amount of not more than
19	\$25,000 per claimant; and
