## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

2 relating to voting for the elective municipal office of controller 3 in areas annexed for limited purposes by certain municipalities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 43.130(a), Local Government Code, is 6 amended to read as follows:

The qualified voters of an area annexed for limited (a) 7 purposes are entitled to vote in municipal elections regarding the 8 election or recall of members of the governing body of the 9 municipality, including the elective office of controller if 10 applicable, or regarding the amendment of the municipal charter. 11 12 The voters may not vote in any bond election. On or after the 15th 13 day but before the fifth day before the date of the first election held in which the residents of an area annexed for limited purposes 14 15 are entitled to vote, the municipality shall publish notice in the form of a quarter-page advertisement in a newspaper of general 16 circulation in the municipality notifying the residents that they 17 are eligible to vote in the election and stating the location of all 18 polling places for the residents. 19

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
