## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to carrying a passenger on an all-terrain vehicle.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subdivision (1), Section 663.001, Transportation
5	Code, is amended to read as follows:
6	(1) "All-terrain vehicle" means a motor vehicle that
7	is:
8	(A) equipped with a saddle for the use of $\underline{:}$
9	(i) the rider; and
10	(ii) a passenger, if the motor vehicle is
11	designed by the manufacturer to transport a passenger;
12	(B) designed to propel itself with three or four
13	tires in contact with the ground;
14	(C) designed by the manufacturer for off-highway
15	use by the operator only; and
16	(D) not designed by the manufacturer for farming
17	or lawn care.
18	SECTION 2. Section 663.036, Transportation Code, is amended
19	to read as follows:
20	Sec. 663.036. <u>CARRYING</u> PASSENGERS [ <del>PROHIBITED</del> ]. A person
21	may not carry a passenger on an all-terrain vehicle operated on
22	public property unless the all-terrain vehicle is designed by the
23	manufacturer to transport a passenger.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
