1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to carrying a passenger on an all-terrain vehicle.  
1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
1-12 SECTION 1. Subdivision (1), Section 663.001, Transportation  
1-13 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-14 (1) "All-terrain vehicle" means a motor vehicle that  
1-15 is:

1-16 (A) equipped with a saddle for the use of:  
1-17 (i) the rider; and  
1-18 (ii) a passenger, if the motor vehicle is  
1-19 designed by the manufacturer to transport a passenger;

1-20 (B) designed to propel itself with three or four  
1-21 tires in contact with the ground;

1-22 (C) designed by the manufacturer for off-highway  
1-23 use by the operator only; and

1-24 (D) not designed by the manufacturer for farming  
1-25 or lawn care.

1-26 SECTION 2. Section 663.036, Transportation Code, is amended  
1-27 to read as follows:

1-28 Sec. 663.036. CARRYING PASSENGERS [PROHIBITED]. A person  
1-29 may not carry a passenger on an all-terrain vehicle operated on  
1-30 public property unless the all-terrain vehicle is designed by the  
1-31 manufacturer to transport a passenger.

1-32 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
