5	SECTION 1. Chapter 623, Transportation Code, is amended by
6	adding Subchapter L to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER L. OCEAN CARGO SHIPPING CONTAINERS
8	Sec. 623.231. DEFINITION. In this subchapter, "ocean cargo
9	shipping container" means an enclosed, standardized, reusable
10	<pre>container that:</pre>
11	(1) is used to pack, ship, move, or transport freight
12	articles, goods, or commodities;
13	(2) is designed to be carried on a trailer and loaded
14	onto a vessel for ocean-borne transportation; and
15	(3) exceeds the weight limitations of this chapter.
16	Sec. 623.232. PERMIT. The department may issue an annual
17	permit for the movement of ocean cargo shipping containers if:
18	(1) the combination of vehicles transporting the
19	<pre>containers has:</pre>
20	(A) a tandem axle weight of not more than 40,000
21	pounds;
22	(B) a single axle weight of not more than 20,000
23	pounds; and
24	(C) a gross weight of not more than 90,000

- 2 (2) the proposed movement of the container does not
- 3 <u>exceed 75 miles from the point of loading to a container port or</u>
- 4 <u>intermodal rail yard in this state.</u>
- 5 Sec. 623.233. PERMIT FEE. The amount of the fee for an
- 6 annual permit issued under Section 623.232 is equal to the amount of
- 7 <u>a fee imposed in connection with a permit issued under Subchapter B.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
