- 2 relating to the issuance of special license plates for recipients 3 of the Distinguished Flying Cross Medal.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 502, Transportation Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 502.2601 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 502.2601. DISTINGUISHED FLYING CROSS MEDAL
- 8 RECIPIENTS. (a) The department shall issue specially designed
- 9 license plates for passenger cars and light trucks owned by
- 10 recipients of the Distinguished Flying Cross Medal.
- 11 (b) The license plates must bear a depiction of the
- 12 Distinguished Flying Cross Medal and the words "Distinguished
- 13 Flying Cross Medal" at the bottom of each plate.
- 14 (c) The department shall issue license plates under this
- 15 section to a person who:
- (1) applies to the county tax assessor-collector of
- 17 the county in which the person resides on a form provided by the
- 18 <u>department;</u>
- 19 (2) pays an annual fee of \$3 in addition to the fee
- 20 prescribed by Section 502.161 and, if personalized prestige license
- 21 plates are issued, in addition to the fee prescribed by Section
- 22 502.251; and
- 23 (3) submits proof that the person has been awarded the
- 24 Distinguished Flying Cross Medal.

- 1 (d) If the license plates issued under this section are
- 2 lost, stolen, or mutilated, the owner of the vehicle for which the
- 3 plates were issued may obtain replacement plates from the
- 4 department by paying the replacement fee prescribed by Section
- 5 502.184(a)(2).
- 6 (e) If the owner of a vehicle registered under this section
- 7 <u>disposes of the vehicle during the registration year, the owner</u>
- 8 shall return the special license plates to the department. The
- 9 owner may then apply for issuance of those plates to another
- 10 <u>vehicle</u>.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
