## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to adjusting formula funding for institutions of higher
- 3 education to account for differences between estimated and actual
- 4 receipts of educational and general funds.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 61.059(c), Education Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (c) Formulas for basic funding shall reflect the role and
- 9 mission of each institution, shall emphasize funding elements that
- 10 directly support faculty, [and] shall reflect both fixed and
- variable elements of cost, and shall include a positive or negative
- 12 adjustment, as appropriate, of the estimated amount of educational
- and general funds to be received by an institution for the biennium
- 14 for which the formulas are established, to account for the
- 15 <u>institution's reconciliation of those funds for the preceding</u>
- biennium as computed and reported under Section 61.065.
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 61.065, Education Code, is amended by
- 18 adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:
- (c) The board shall adopt a uniform system of financial
- 20 accounting of all educational and general funds received by an
- 21 institution of higher education, including tuition, laboratory
- 22 <u>fees, student teaching fees, organized activity fees, proceeds from</u>
- 23 the sale of educational and general equipment, and indirect cost
- 24 recovery fees received by an institution. The system must require

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- 1 each institution to reconcile the estimated amount of educational
- 2 and general funds used to determine state appropriations for the
- 3 institution for the most recently completed state fiscal biennium
- 4 to the actual amount of educational and general funds that the
- 5 institution received during that biennium.
- 6 (d) Each institution shall report its reconciliation under
- 7 Subsection (c) to the board, the comptroller, and the Legislative
- 8 Budget Board at the time required by the board.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
